Diabetes – where are Americans now?

- 80% of diagnosed Type II diabetes is attributable to obesity (NIH)
- 8.3% of American population is diabetic (*NIH*)
- □ 6% increase in diabetes per year (NIH)
- Between 1990 -1998, prevalence of diagnosed diabetes increased 33% (CDC 2002)



Autoimmune Disorders Take off for U.S. Women

- Autoimmune disorders afflict nearly 24 million Americans (9 out of 10 Americans cannot name a single one of these diseases)
- ☐ They include type 1 diabetes, Lupus, Graves' disease, vasculitis, myasthenia gravis, vitiligo, rheumatoid arthritis, celiac disease, scleroderma and upwards of 80 others
- **□75** to 80% of all sufferers are women

Autoimmune Diseases

- Autoimmune diseases are the eighth leading cause of death among women
- Afflicting them in their prime, shortening their lifespan by fifteen years
- Autoimmune diseases represent a yearly health-care burden of more than \$120 billion, compared to the yearly health-care burden of \$70 billion for direct medical costs for cancer.

Autoimmune Diseases

Prevalence in comparison to other diseases

- 2.2 million women are living with breast cancer and 7.2 million women have coronary disease
- Estimated 9.8 million women are afflicted with one of the 7 more common autoimmune diseases

Neurological Disorders

Neurological disorders from Autism to Alzheimer's are on the rise

- ☐ Autism has increased from 1 in 2000 children 20 years ago, to 1 in 110 children today
- Autism Speaks and the CDC co-sponsored a workshop entitled "U.S. Data to Evaluate Changes in the Prevalence of Autism Spectrum Disorders," found environmental factors such as pesticides and other toxins to be cause

Alzheimer's

Alzheimer's is on the rise:

- Alzheimer's is one of the top ten causes of death in the U.S. at present.
- ☐ Anorexic patients are more at risk for Alzheimer's
- □ Alzheimer's now thought to be diabetes for the brain driven by insulin resistance and/or glucose levels that are too high

Allergies Among Children

Allergies

Especially food allergies increased by 18% between 1997-2007



Linked to Genetically Engineered (GE), Hyperhybridized (HH), carcinogenic, autogenic, diabetic, obesogenic and addictive food additives.

■Soy allergies

Increased in the UK by 50% with introduction of GE soy
